Top Colors For 2023

The new year is a great time to set goals, establish healthier habits, and promote growth and learning. This year, many paint manufacturers also see it as a great opportunity to reset, recenter and rewrite the design and ambience of our homes to suit our journey for the year ahead.

Viva Magenta Take Pantone's 2023 Color of the Year, Viva Magenta, for example. This bold hue provides a perfect change of pace for the year ahead. "Viva Magenta is brave and fearless, and a pulsating

color whose exuberance promotes a joyous and optimistic celebration, writing a new narrative," Pantone noted.

Raspberry Blush Benjamin Moore's Raspberry Blush is a similarly charismatic coral hue that can be used to add a lively pop of color to any space.

"People are ready to bring color back into the home, taking a step outside their color comfort zones," said Andrea Magno, color marketing & development director at Benjamin Moore, in a press release. "Raspberry Blush 2008-30 and the Color Trends 2023 palette empower the use of statement colors that deliver delight and personality, while transforming rooms for incredible results."



Sherwin Williams and Dunn Edwards opted for more muted red-based tones with Redend Point and Terra Rosa, respectively. These soft, earthy, subtle pink hues are grounding and warm, and add rich, sophisticated

color to the home.

"It is a heartening hue that invites compassion and connection into any space," said Sue Wadden, director of color marketing at Sherwin-Williams, of Redend Point in a press release. "The color is a natural choice for those looking for a warm and joyful neutral in both interiors and exteriors."

Other paint manufacturers, such as Behr, went a

different direction. Behr's 2023 Color of the Year, Blank Canvas, is a rich neutral to help renew every space in the home, from entryways to living rooms to bedrooms.

Blank Canvas "Blank Canvas effortlessly offers a clean and inviting blank slate that allows individuality and creativity to flow freely," stated Erika Woelfel, Vice President of Color and Creative

Services at Behr Paint Company, in a press release. "This white easily harmonizes with a wide range of hues, including neutrals, earth tones and pastels for a charming and cozy appeal."



Valspar also opted for a primarily softer palette, with its 2023 Colors of the Year palette. Neutral colors such as Ivory Brown, Cozy White and Villa Grey are included alongside colors

such as Southern Road and Desert Carnation, which are more in line with the year's bolder red-based

NAHB's New Water Toolkit Provides Builders With Water Management Tools And Resources

As water costs continue to rise across the country, and some areas face droughts, aridification and water supply constraints, water efficiency strategies in residential construction can play an important role, and provide multiple benefits for builders and consumers alike.

"Conservation is the No. 1 technique – finding ways to use less water," stated Craig Karn, principal at Consilium Design in Denver and vice chair of the Sustainability and Green Building Subcommittee, who also chaired NAHB's Water Task Group. "And the secret to conservation is building awareness."

One way in which NAHB is working to build awareness is through NAHB's recently released A Builder's Toolkit for Water. The toolkit not only explores issues surrounding water management, but also provides case studies that highlight how different areas across the country have tackled key issues such as water conservation, flooding and more.

The toolkit also includes helpful tips for builders to share with home owners to help them improve their own conservation efforts.

"We must learn to live better using less water," Karn added. "We can help consumers be better water stewards by educating them on everything from the drip irrigation system to how they can best use their smart water meter."



BUILD-PAC Delivers Results In 2022 Midterm Elections

As millions of voters cast their ballots during another pivotal election year, BUILD-PAC - NAHB's bipartisan fundraising arm to elect pro-housing candidates - delivered in helping to ensure the incoming Congress supports industry-friendly policies.

This election cycle, BUILD-PAC worked closely with House and Senate leaders, contributing to 376 campaigns and endorsing 183 candidates. Increased investment from NAHB members allowed BUILD-PAC to disburse a total of \$2.8 million to federal candidates and committees for these elections.

Of the 376 candidates, BUILD-PAC remained active in 100 competitive or toss-up House and Senate

races. Thanks to the PAC's involvement, 92% of supported campaigns won their races on Nov. 8. And of the candidates who received BUILD-PAC's endorsements, 174 won their races - tallying a 95% success rate.

NAHB's government affairs team is hard at work with incumbent and newly elected officials to elevate the key issues in the home building industry and deliver results in the form of beneficial policies. BUILD-PAC is already preparing for the 2023-2024 election cycle, with fundraising events across the country raising money to endorse and elect candidates that serve NAHB members.




